

Public tender: Scholarship „Deutschlandstipendium“ at Hochschule Wismar



Already for the 4th time Hochschule Wismar provides scholarships called Deutschlandstipendium to committed and high-achieving students.

In the academic year 2015/16 the following scholarships will be granted:

- One scholarship for students of all faculties
- One subject-related scholarship for students of the Master's degree distance learning programme "Integrative StadtLand-Entwicklung", Faculty of Design
- One subject-related scholarship for students of the Bachelor's degree distance learning programme "Sportmanagement", Business School
- One subject-related scholarship for students of programmes in mechanical engineering, electrical engineering or multimedia technology, Faculty of Engineering
- Two subject-related scholarships for students of all Departments of the Faculty of Engineering

The financial support will be 300€ per month. The scholarship funds do not count towards grants awarded under the Federal Training Assistance Act (BAföG). There is no legal claim to the scholarship. The scholarship cannot be awarded to Ph.D. students. It cannot be combined with other scholarships in accordance with § 4 Stipendiengesetz.

The scholarship will be awarded for two semesters, beginning on 1st September 2015. Students already receiving a Deutschlandstipendium may apply for prolongation.

The award of a scholarship requires an application by the student or prospective students. Entitled to apply are German or Foreign students or prospective students at Hochschule Wismar who have to fulfill the following requirements:

- The applicant has to be enrolled in a diploma, bachelor's or master's degree course within the standard period of study, or
- The applicant is a prospective student willing to enrol in a diploma, bachelor's or master's degree course. He has a particularly good development, so that above-average achievements can be expected for his studies as well.

Conditions for the scholarship are:

- Outstanding achievements at school, professional training/business, or studies which you can prove by the final grade of your university entrance qualification or the average of the previously provided grades of your studies or the final grade of your first academic degree
- Prove of outstanding success, like awards, prizes, internships relating to the field of study
- Extracurricular, non-academic or nonprofessional commitment: voluntary/social/political engagement, commitment within the university, participation in religious communities, other associations and clubs or
- Special personal or family circumstances such as illness, disability, care of own children or high-maintenance dependents, work in a family-business, family origins, migrant background, personal needs, half-orphans/ orphans, guardian for siblings, course-related employments.

In case of equal suitability, women will be considered preferentially in those programmes where women are underrepresented.

You can send your application by E-Mail or post or submit it personally at the Robert-Schmidt-Institut der Hochschule Wismar.

The deadline for tenders ends 26th June 2015.

All documents have to be submitted in single copy. Incomplete requests will not be considered.
