

Call for Deutschlandstipendium at the Hochschule Wismar

In the academic year 2021/22 the Hochschule Wismar provides scholarships called "Deutschlandstipendium" again, to highly committed and particularly high-achieving students.

The following scholarships are going to be expected:

- nine unbound scholarships for students of all faculties
- five subject-related scholarships for students from non-academic families in the MINT study courses of all faculties
- one unbound scholarship for student of the Faculty of Design
- two subject-related scholarship for students of the subject area "Architecture", Faculty of Design
- two subject-related scholarships for students of the subject area "Civil Engineering", Faculty of Engineering
- two subject-related scholarship for students of the subject area "Maritime, systems engineering and logistics", Faculty of Engineering
- two subject-related scholarship for students of the subject area "Mechanical / Electrical Engineering", Faculty of Engineering
- one subject-related scholarship for students of the distance learning programmes "Sports Management", Business School
- one subject-related scholarship for students of the subject area "Mechanical / Electrical Engineering", Faculty of Engineering
- one subject-related scholarship for students of the subject area "Business / Applied Informatics", Faculty of Business
- one subject-related scholarship for students of the subject area "Business Informatics", Faculty of Business

(as amended on 12th April 2021)

The scholarship will be awarded for two semesters, beginning on 1st September 2021. The financial support will be 300 Euro per month. The scholarship funds do not count towards grants awarded under the Federal Training Assistance Act (BAföG). There is no legal claim to the scholarship. The scholarship cannot be awarded to Ph.D. students. It cannot be combined with other scholarships in accordance with § 4 Stipendiengesetz.

The award of a scholarship requires an application by the student or prospective student. Entitled to apply are German or foreign students or prospective students at the Hochschule Wismar who fulfil the following requirements:

- The applicant has to be enrolled in a diploma, bachelor's or master's degree course within the standard period of study, **or**
- The applicant is a prospective student willing to enrol in a diploma, bachelor's or master's degree course at Hochschule Wismar. He has a particularly good educational development, so that above-average achievements can be expected for his studies as well.

Selection criteria for the scholarship are:

- outstanding achievements at school, professional training/business, or studies which you can
 prove by the final grade of your university entrance qualification or the average of the previously
 provided grades of your studies or the final grade of your first academic degree,
- proof of outstanding success, like awards, prizes, internships relating to the field of study
- extracurricular, non-academic or nonprofessional commitment: voluntary/social/political engagement, commitment within the university, participation in religious communities, other associations and clubs
- special personal or family circumstances such as illness, disability, care of own children or highmaintenance dependents, work in a family-business, family origins, migrant background, personal needs, half-orphans/ orphans, guardian for siblings, course-related employments

In case of equal suitability, women will be considered preferentially in those programmes where women are underrepresented.

The application period begins at the 19th of April and the deadline ends on the 30th May 2021.
