

# Call for Applications for the Deutschlandstipendium at Hochschule Wismar



For the winter semester 2024/2025, Hochschule Wismar will once again support particularly talented and high-performing students with the Deutschlandstipendium. It is anticipated that 50 scholarships will be awarded (as of April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024), namely:

- thirteen unrestricted scholarships for students from all faculties,
- five subject-specific scholarships for students from non-academic families from all faculties or a STEM discipline,
- seven subject-specific scholarships for students in the field of Civil Engineering, Faculty of Engineering,
- one subject-specific scholarship for students in the field of Architecture, Faculty of Architecture and Design,
- two subject-specific scholarships for students of the Faculty of Engineering,
- one subject-specific scholarship for students in the field of Accounting & Controlling, Wismar Business School,
- ten subject-specific scholarships for students in the fields of Civil Engineering, Smart Building Engineering, Building Protection, Facility Management, Faculty of Engineering, and Architecture, Interior Architecture, Architectural Lighting Design, Faculty of Architecture and Design (preferably Civil Engineering and Architecture),
- one subject-specific scholarship for students in the field of Civil Engineering, Faculty of Engineering or Architecture, Faculty of Architecture and Design,
- one subject-specific scholarship for students in the fields of Mechanical/Process and Energy Engineering (M.A.), Mechatronics, Faculty of Engineering or Business Informatics, Wismar Business School (in this prioritization),
- one subject-specific scholarship for students in the fields of IT, Faculty of Engineering or Business Administration, Wismar Business School,
- one subject-specific scholarship for students in the field of Business Administration (B.A.), Wismar Business School,
- two subject-specific scholarships for students in the fields of International Management and/or Digital Logistics and Management, Wismar Business School,
- one subject-specific scholarship for students in the fields of Engineering, Technology or Mechanical Engineering, Faculty of Engineering,
- one subject-specific scholarship for students in the field of Business Informatics, Wismar Business School,
- one subject-specific scholarship for students in the field of Business Administration, Wismar Business School,
- one subject-specific scholarship for students in the field of Communication Design and Media, Faculty of Architecture and Design,
- one subject-specific scholarship for students in the fields of Electrical Engineering or Mechanical Engineering, Faculty of Engineering.

Scholarship disbursement will commence from September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, for a duration of two semesters. The scholarship amount is €300 per month, independent of income, and can be combined with support from BAföG. Double funding with other scholarships according to § 4 of the Scholarship Act is excluded.

The award of a scholarship requires an application from the student or prospective student. Eligible applicants are German and foreign students and prospective students of Hochschule Wismar who are either:

- Enrolled in a diploma, bachelor's, or master's program within the standard period of study, **or**
- Prospective students who intend to pursue a diploma, bachelor's, or master's program and whose previous academic record indicates excellent academic performance.

The selection criteria for the Deutschlandstipendium at Hochschule Wismar are:

- Outstanding performance in school or vocational education/profession or in university studies – these can be demonstrated, for example, by the grade of the university entrance qualification or an average grade of previous academic achievements in studies or by the final grade of the first academic degree;
- Special achievements such as awards, prizes, internships related to the field of study;
- Extracurricular or non-disciplinary engagement – voluntary, societal, social, (university) political engagement; involvement in religious communities, associations, or clubs;
- Special personal or family circumstances, e.g., illness, disabilities, care of own children or dependent relatives, participation in family business, family background or migration background, neediness, half/full orphans, legal guardian for siblings.

In case of equal fulfillment of the selection criteria, women will be given preferential consideration in scholarship allocation, provided they are studying or intend to study in a program where women are underrepresented at the university.

**The application period starts on 22<sup>nd</sup> of April and ends on 31<sup>st</sup> of May 2024.**
