Who really knows GOTTLOB FREGE (1848-1925)? Only a few people connect the name with one of the greatest logicians in history. His "Logik von Funktion und Argument" (Logic of Function and Argument) is a crucial prerequisite for computer science and information technology. All his life Frege has been attracted by his North-German home region. He spent his childhood and schooldays in the Hanseatic town Wismar and his last years nearby, in the village Bad Kleinen.

The Gottlob Frege Centre of Hochschule Wismar was founded in 2000. In honour of Gottlob Frege the centre organized an International Conference in May 2013 in Wismar. The conference was attended as well by Mathematicians as by experts in Analytical Philosophy. In the conference proceedings well-known scientists write about:

- Frege's contribution to Mathematics, Logic and Philosophy,
- Frege's scientific views and views he strongly criticized,
- Frege's communication with other outstanding scientists,
- who continued Frege's work and who called it into question,
- what we can learn from Frege's work today.
